A PROCLAMATION

GOUT AWARENESS DAY

- WHEREAS:** More than 9 million Americans suffer with gout, the most common form of inflammatory arthritis, caused by uric acid build-up in the joints; and
- WHEREAS:** Gout is a chronic disease characterized by sudden and excruciating painful attacks; and
- WHEREAS:** Gout impacts a patient's workplace, community, and daily quality of life; and
- WHEREAS:** Stigma, lack of awareness, and misinformation may hinder treatment for gout; and
- WHEREAS:** Increased public awareness can improve access to timely treatment and quality care for patients experiencing gout; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 22, 2023, as GOUT AWARENESS DAY in Georgia.
